

Adult Leadership Positions at Scout Camp

Transportation Coordinator

This individual will coordinate the transportation for the scouts and adults to and from Bartle Scout reservation. This individual will coordinate with the Troop Quartermaster for the use of the trailer for transportation of camp boxes and troop gear to camp. In addition, this individual will provide maps and coordinate transportation for parents' day. Normally for parents' day this requires providing maps and instructions on how to get to Bartle.

Equipment Coordinator

This individual will coordinate with the Troop Quartermaster to see that the equipment needed for the 10 days at Bartle is provided for the troop. This will include the physical equipment as well as the consumable supplies needed. This individual will also see that the equipment needed for the scouts working on Tenderfoot, 2nd Class and 1st Class is brought to camp in coordination with the first year scout coordinator. This individual will oversee the scouts in setting up and breaking camp.

Hydration Coordinator

This individual will supervise the hydration for the scouts. This will include providing for Gatorade or similar drinks as well as fresh fruit. This will include arranging for someone to make trips off the reservation for fruit and other hydration supplies. This individual will also be responsible for supervising the Ice order at camp.

Mic-O-Say Coordinator

This adult must be in the Tribe of Mic-O-Say. This individual will see that all paperwork needed for recognition by the Tribe is completed. In addition, this individual will coordinate providing the appropriate equipment for the scouts called as Brave or Warrior. In addition, this individual will coordinate the post ceremony activities for our Tribesmen. This individual will be responsible for the KP Duty roster in coordination with the Outpost coordinator.

Outpost Coordinator

This individual will coordinate the application for Outpost activities including soliciting scouts for their interest, filing the forms with the Council to enroll in Outpost activities, then assigning specific scouts to activities when we receive the assignments from the Council. In addition, this individual will be need to see that our outpost fees are paid when we get to camp and will need to coordinate adult leadership for the outpost activities and communicate and remind the scouts going on outpost activities of the activities.

First Year Scout Program Coordinator

Ideally this individual will have a scout in the first year program at camp. This individual will coordinate the advancement activities for the first year scouts, and those other

scouts who have not yet completed their First Class rank. This will include following the camp first year scout program and arranging for the in camp activities needed to support the first year scouts. This individual should attend all of the camp first year scout activities with the first year scouts. It is assumed that a new scout parent will have assistance in planning and understanding how the new scout program at camp works.

Merit Badge Coordinator

This individual will coordinate the merit badge sign up prior to camp. This individual will then work with the scouts on the first day of merit badges to see that scouts know where the merit badges are. This individual will be responsible for enlisting other adults to follow up with merit badges to be sure scouts are making appropriate progress in the merit badges.

Sanitation Coordinator

This individual will supervise the lolly clean up and the overall camp cleanups daily and for visitor's Sunday. In addition, this individual will supervise the daily tent inspections for the scouts.

Activities Coordinator

This individual will coordinate our campfires and evening activities such as the hike to Iconium. This individual will be the resource to scouts who will plan and execute the evening activities.

Scout Banker

This individual will provide safekeeping of scout funds. The individual will provide "banking" hours at least twice a day where scouts can obtain money. This individual will monitor scout total spending and counsel scouts as needed with respect to conserving funds so that they last the entire 10 days.

Conservation Coordinator

This individual will coordinate the conservation project for the troop during the stay at Bartle. This includes determining an appropriate conservation project and getting it approved by the Commissioner. This individual will then work with the boy leaders of the troop to see that the conservation project is completed in a satisfactory manner.

Medications Coordinator

This individual will be responsible for obtaining all medications from parents prior to leaving for camp. This individual will then hold the medications and will have medication calls for the scouts at the appropriate time of day. This individual will supervise all scouts in taking their medications.
